NOTES AND INSTRUCTIONS

Marriages to Seychellois

Documents to be submitted:

- Birth Certificate or copy of your passport's bio-data page;
- Marriage certificate;
- Spouse death certificate if applicable;
- Minor children's birth certificate;
- Police character certificate;
- One passport size photograph.

- (i) You are married to a citizen of Seychelles for at least five years or more, your marriage is still subsisting and you have resided in Seychelles as a legal resident for an aggregate period of not less than five years;
- (ii) If you have been married for at least five years, your marriage is not subsisting or your spouse has since died and you have resided in Seychelles for an aggregate period of not less than five years as a legal resident;

Permit applicable fee: Sr. 1000/-

Note: If your marriage no longer subsists, your spouse has passed away, you have Seychellois children and you have been a legal resident for less than five years, you will be eligible to apply for the permit after having completed five years residency in Seychelles. You may however continue to reside in Seychelles as a legal resident.

Priority Worker

Documents to be submitted:

- CV including employment history;
- University degree certificate(s);
- One passport size photograph;
- Copy of passport's bio-data page;
- Police character certificate.

Non-Seychellois who have resided in Seychelles as a legal resident for an aggregate period of not less than five years and -

- (i) possess extraordinary ability in Science, Arts, Education, Economics, Business, Law or Sports;
- (ii) hold a University Degree at Doctorate, Masters and Bachelor's in areas likely to significantly contribute to the development of the country.
- (iii) have made significant contribution to the development of Seychelles;

Permit fee: Sr. 10,000/-

Non-Seychellois Students

Documents to be submitted:

- CV;
- University degree certificate(s);
- One passport size photograph;
- Copy of passport's bio-data page;
- Police character certificate.

Who have lived for a period of at least five years and studied up to the level of secondary in Seychelles, and graduated from a University and being employed for at least 2 years on Gainful Occupation Permit (GOP).

Permit fee: Sr. 10,000/-

Investors

Documents to be submitted:

- Police character certificate including for those persons to be endorsed on permit;
- Full details and Documentary evidence of investment;
- Copy of passport's bio-data page.
- One full face passport size photograph of applicant and persons to be endorsed on the permit.

- (i) Non-Seychellois who have invested an equivalent in Seychelles Rupees of not less than US\$ 1 million and have been a legal resident in Seychelles for a period of not less one year ;
- OR
- (ii) have invested of an equivalent of not less than US\$ 1million and has had business association/affiliation with Seychelles for a period of not less than five years.

Permit Fee: Sr. 150,000/-

Conditions following approval of the permit:

A) The permit holder shall be entitled to the following:

- (i) Gainfully occupied without the need for a Gainful Occupation Permit (GOP);
- (ii) 50% sanction fee for acquisition of immovable property;
- (iii) Minor children of the permit holder may be endorsed on permit until they reach the age of 18 years after which they will need to apply for another relevant permit;

B) Permanent Residence permit holders are not entitled to free Health care benefit.

Processing of Application:

A processing fee of Sr. 1,000 is payable on submission of your application.

Applications are to be submitted at the Immigration and Civil Status Department, Immigration Office, Independence House, First Floor, Victoria, Mahé, Seychelles.
